Battle of Victoria Successful

It was quite a battle. Some people wished to remove the historic "Gates" so the traffic signs would be more visible. Others didn't wish any signal at all while still others had further ideas.

At long last the fateful decision was made and a very favorable one it was. The "Gates" prevailed and only favorable comments on the installation are now heard. Your association spent hours on this problem.

Sway on "Kay" Like "L"

All of us probably heard about our "Kay" line and its proposed removal some weeks back. This was really a dilly of a problem trying to please everyone. (Just try it sometime.) It remained for our likeable realtor and Public Utilities Commission member, Mr. Cameron, to arrange a district meeting with the genial traffic expert and consultant, Mr. Marmion Mills, to show us graphically the nature of the "Kay" dilemma — crowded on one hand and losing money on the other :

We hope that the large proportion of the Torracers are satisfied with the results obtained:

- 1. A complete repaying of Ocean Avenue. (glory bo 1) to the tune of several hundred thousand dollars. (\$000,000)
- 2. A continuing of our beloved "Kay" through the tunnel along Ocean Avenue until evening.
- 3. A new bus line in the evenings from the end of the "L" line to the tunnel thence continuing over Ocean Avenue and back again.

Your association was in there all the time on this problem, together with the aid of West of Twin Peaks Council. A fine job (we believe) was accomplished.

Watch the improvements on Ocean Avenue as they develop - they have started.
